7 *repealed.*

8 *(b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—The Dodd-Frank*
9 *Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (12*
10 *U.S.C. 5301 et seq.) is amended—*

11 *(1) by striking section 1502; and*

12 *(2) in the table of contents in section 1(b) of such*
13 *Act, by striking the item relating to section 1502.*
